Before the Registrar can roster them for apprentice teaching (course number 300 in the department in which the apprentice teaching is done), this form must be completed, approved, and submitted to the Registrar. To complete the course, apprentice teachers must submit a written report on their experiences to the central coordinator in the Provost's Office.
